

Hi ladies - let's talk money,

- ❖ You do not have to write separate checks to pay dues & green fees – one check is OK – signed & made payable to SWGL (not to me, the course, SWGA or NNWGA).
- ❖ Remember – you paid a minimum of \$20 for your Course Selections and that is part of your green fee. So, if the green fee for a course is \$50 you only have to send in \$30.
- ❖ You may pay for the whole year if you like.
- ❖ Balance of green fees are always due one month prior to play. You can always check My Play Days on the website: [www.swgl.org](http://www.swgl.org) to see the amount you've already paid for that course & amount owing. My Play Days is usually updated on Sunday of each week, but you can always email or call me if you have a question.
  - If you do not pay your green fee in a timely manner you could be removed from that course and someone from the Wait List moved up. It's very important to pay on time.
- ❖ If you're on a Wait List – you are not required to pay any additional green fee. If you don't make the play list, your money will be transferred to another course or refunded.
  - If you're on a Wait List, you need to let me know if you do not intend on playing.

If you win prize money, you may use that to pay towards your next green fee – just email me.

If you cancel less than 7 days prior to the play date, you will be charged a \$30 Processing Fee. The remaining green fee will not be refunded until after the play day in the event the course charges us for your cancellation. A replacement player does not excuse you from this fee.
